ABOUT US

The New Transitions Center is a newly founded non-profit dedicated to young adults with special needs who have aged-out of support services. The Center offers structured day-habilitation services and core programming at our community "Hub" located in the heart of Roanoke, Texas.

As advocates for those with special needs, The Center provides engaging community activities and special events.

WHO WE SERVE

The Center supports young adults with varying degrees of intellectual, developmental, and physical disabilities. As The Center serves those that have a more profound need we cannot accept individuals who exhibit high and frequent behavioral incidents to ensure safety for all. We strive to maintain a 1:4 staff to participant ratio to ensure quality programming and care for your loved ones.

We prioritize those with more significant needs including non-verbal, non-ambulatory and those that may require full assistance with toileting. Our staff and facility are adapted to accommodate these needs with dignity and respect.

The Center offers structured daily programs focused on life skills, communication and education. We host special events and organize community based field trips that address the unmet needs of this community.

Step 1: Initial Application and Phone Screening

Step 2: Tour

An after hours in-person or virtual tour of our facility to meet our team and discuss in more depth the needs of your family.

Step 3: Shadow Day

Join your loved one for a day at The Center to get a better feel for those we serve and our daily programming. **At least 1 shadow day is required and will consist of supervised participation in all Center activities for that day.**

Step 4: Final Application and Intake

Submit final application with additional required documentation. This stage includes the review of program goals and membership preferences. A contract outline membership dues as well as relevant policies and procedures will be established.
